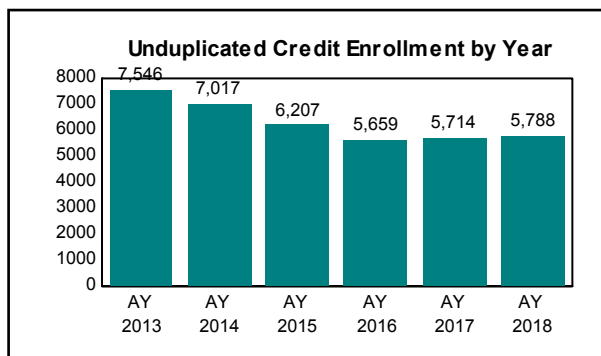

## Enrollment

(Based on Academic Year 2018 credit enrollment.)

**Atlanta Tech's Main Campus in Fulton County enrolled 5,788 students** in credit courses during Academic Year 2018. This was the Full Time Equivalent (FTE) of 3,031 students (based on the sum of total credit hours for all students).

The **five year percent change** in credit enrollment, from AY 2013 to AY 2018 = **-23.3%**

**High School students** enrolled at Atlanta Tech's Main Campus: **268**

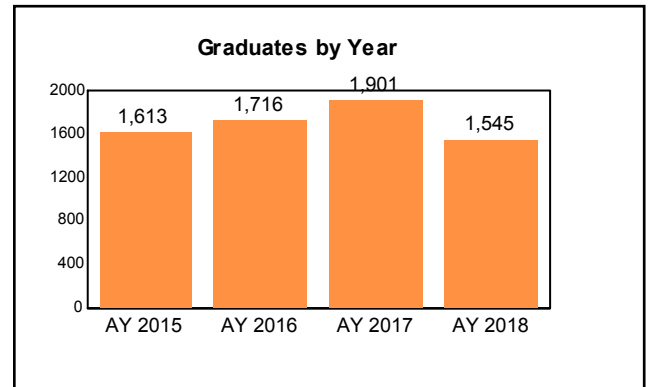

### Graduates

(Based on Academic Year 2018 graduates.)

Workforce development is a key mission of Georgia's technical college system. **An unduplicated total of 1,545 graduates** received awards from this institution in Academic Year 2018.

The **three year percent change** in graduates, from AY 2015 to AY 2018 = **-4.2%**
